- Working knowledge of plumbing, heating, refrigeration, carpentry and building structure

Responsibilities

- Assists the Facilities Manager with all aspects of maintenance operations, encompassing mechanical, electrical, renovations and equipment maintenance and repairs within the hospital, garage, ambulance garages (Nipigon and Red Rock) and medical clinics (Nipigon and Beardmore)
- Grounds and equipment maintenance
- Able to work with other disciplines and be able to teach and delegate work to staff
- Perform tasks that involve repeated lifting, bending, kneeling, standing, walking, pushing, and climbing (e.g. ladders and other equipment)
- Work in a safe manner
- Understand confidentiality
- Self-motivated with the ability to organize own workload
- Flexibility with scheduling due to the nature of the position and response to weather
- Willing and ready to address problems whenever breakdowns occur or to contact companies or other tradesmen to perform specific repairs
- Understand the use of and can use personal protective equipment
- On-call rotation and as needed; must reside less than 30 minutes from the hospital
